	/	A Peek At What We Are Learning
	Literacy	 We will continue to build upon the CAFE Reading process as part of a whole school approach to reading. The CAFE process encourages students to use a variety of strategies to comprehend and engage with the texts they read. Our focus will be on strategies and skills that 'good readers' use to decode and understand new texts. Students will bring home levelled readers each night and will be shown how to select 'good fit' books in the library to be used during sustained reading in class. We will link our Literacy to our inquiry unit "Relationships and Belonging"
	Maths	knowledge of numbers 1-50, sequencing numbers before and after a given number. The children will learn to count backwards and forwards in number patterns of 2's, 5's and 10's. Addition will also be introduced. In Geometry we will be exploring 2D shapes and patterns.
	Religion/ Inquiry	During Term One, children will create a prayer mat for the classroom which will be the centerpiece for morning meditation and prayer. Religion will be taught using an Inquiry approach so that lessons become more meaningful and children will be able to make connections with Religion and other units of study. The Inquiry unit this term is focusing on Belonging and Becoming and will link with the school's theme <i>Treat others as you would like them to treat you</i> . In the lead up to Easter, children will participate in an Ash Wednesday Prayer Service and prepare themselves for Easter by identifying ways in which they can better themselves during the period of Lent.

ICT/Digital Technologies

Thanks to the P&F, last year I was able to purchase a Virtual Reality kit. It has finally arrived and we are all very excited about its prospects. This term all students will be immersed in new learning using the Virtual Reality headsets and an app called Google Expeditions. Imagine a class full of children taking an immersive, guided tour through some of the cultural gems and natural marvels of our world (and even some off planet!). The idea that we could access 360, immersive imagery was like science fiction a few years ago, until Google combined the power of VR headsets with gigapixel quality imagery and the Expeditions software which provides detailed background notes in each scene. The possibilities are endless and now we are able to take the whole class on a virtual field trip.
